

RoHS Declaration

Nilfisk's mission statement is "We enable sustainable cleaning worldwide to improve quality of life", hence supporting the fundamental aim of restricting the use of certain hazardous chemicals in order to improve the protection of human health and the environment, including the RoHS Directive.

The RoHS 1 Directive (2002/95/EC) entered into force in 2003 and was replaced by RoHS 2 Directive (2011/65/EC) in January 2013.

RoHS 2 covers all EEE (Electrical and Electronic Equipment), unless specifically listed as an exemption. In addition, 4 phthalates (DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP) were added to Annex II of restricted substances by Directive 2015/863/EU with compliance deadline July 22nd 2019. Seeing that these substances are a part of the REACH Regulation (1907/2006/EC) they are already a focus of Nilfisk and we do not anticipate any problems.

Additional requirements within RoHS 2 have also been implemented, such as RoHS becoming a CE-marking directive with appertaining EU declaration of conformity, drawing up technical documentation and carry out internal production control procedure in accordance with Module A of Annex II in Decision 768/2008/EEC.
